Eligibility

Students must be pursuing one of the following undergraduate degrees:

A minimum cumulative 3.000 GPA is required.

A maximum of 16 graduate credits completed as an undergraduate can be used toward the Master of Science degree.

- One to two courses from ENVR or EEMB 5000-6999

REQUIRED COURSES TO COMPLETE AS A GRADUATE STUDENT

- ESP Seminar course that was not previously taken
 - PPUA 6101 Environmental Science & Policy Seminar 1 (4SH)
 - ENVR 6102 Environmental Science & Policy Seminar 2 (4 SH)
- One 4-credit College of Science skills course
- One 4-credit College of Social Science and Humanities skills course
- Two 4-credit elective courses from COS or CSSH-approved electives lists
